Psalm 2:1-12

Two Viewpoints

- 1. About David
- 2. About Jesus Christ

Voice of David – Nations, Kings, Rulers Psalm 2.1-3

Restless, angry kings of the earth who are opposed to God and His rule.

"Men are opposed to God in their sin and God is opposed to men in His holiness." J.I. Packer

Voice of God – He Laughs Psalm 3.4-6

God laughs at the foolishness of those who oppose Him.

God's laughter turns into anger, and He acts by installing His King, the Anointed One, as King. Psalm 2 is a promise.

Voice of the Son – Rod of Iron Psalm 2.7-9

Three aspects of the Son:

- 1. The installed King is God's "adopted" Son.
- 2. The adoption comes with an inheritance.
- 3. The right of the Son to rule includes the right to execute judgement.

The Son was installed "today". "Today" was the day of Christ's resurrection.

Voice of David – Application and Invitation Psalm 2.10-12 Five applications that can become our applications.

- 1. Insight give attention to seeking after God.
- 2. Submit to God's instruction.
- 3. Serve God in reverence because of what He has saved you from.
- 4. Rejoice with trembling because you did not get what you deserve.
- 5. Worship "Kiss the Son". A sense of urgency. A sense of intensity.

One More Thing - Take Refuge in Him

Taking refuge equals trusting God will do what He said He will do.

Trust God will keep you safe.

God will bless you with His goodness.
